

Sewing Camp *With Jennifer Serr*

Winter 2009 / Spring 2010

Welcome to Sewing with Jennifer Serr 2009. In these Camps for kids, we embrace the exciting world of craft and design. Students will cultivate many design skills including the use of color, composition, sewing and creative thinking. We will explore numerous avenues of inspiration through our work on each project.

Each camp day will begin with a short demonstration and practice of a sewing or design technique, followed by work on the sewing project. We break for lunch or snack time and eat on-site, either in our workspace or on the patio outside (please provide your child with a bag lunch for all-day camps). The afternoon will be spent sewing and refining our new designing skills. In the afternoon we will clean up and have a special snack. For weekly after school classes, students will be guided through an individual project of their choice throughout the term. Let's get started and have some fun!

Each student will need to come prepared with a sewing box and portable sewing machine. Additionally they will need fabric to create their project. Sewing camp will provide some additional materials for embellishment and creativity.

Supplies

General Sewing Supplies for your sewing box, basket or bag:

Paper Scissors, Fabric Scissors, Sewing Machine Needles, Hand sewing Needles
Thread, Seam Ripper, Pins, Soft Measuring Tape, 2" x 18" Flexible Clear Ruler
Pens, pencils, eraser,

Bring to Class:

Sewing machine and sewing box (see above).

A pattern (for tote class, if not using one of the instructors).

Fashion fabric along with sewing notions appropriate to your project—zippers, thread, buttons, hook & eye closures etc. (see pattern envelope for a list)

Pricing

Three-Day Winter Camp - \$200

After School Registration - \$25 – ensures your child a spot in the class of their choice. In addition, registration fee covers snacks and random (or forgotten) supplies used throughout the term.

Group Lesson Monthly rate for After School Classes (3 or more students) - \$160/month
per child for weekly classes.

Private After School Class - \$50/per class per child for a 1 _ hour class.

Payment of Fees: Payment for one-day camp is due at registration. Payment for three-day camp can be made in payments. Balance is due two weeks prior to beginning of each camp. We accept cash, checks or credit cards (Visa or MasterCard). There will be a convenience fee of \$5 added to credit card transactions

Care of Students: Sewing Camp and it's instructors are not responsible for providing before or after class care for students. Parent or Guardian is required to pick student up no later than 3pm of each class day.

Injuries: Parents, legal guardians of minors, students and adult students waive the right to any legal action for any injury sustained on or around property resulting from any activity conducted by the students before, during, or after class time.
